

VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS TO VOTE IN THE UPCOMING VILLAGE ELECTION

Only persons who are duly registered to vote at their Saltaire address may vote in the Village of Saltaire election. If you are not currently registered to vote from your Saltaire address with the Suffolk County Board of Elections, in order to vote in the Saltaire election you must register either (1) with the Suffolk County Board of Elections, or (2) with the Village of Saltaire by annual personal registration.

(1) To register in Suffolk County, contact the Suffolk County Board of Elections at (631) 852-4500, or contact the Village Office and a registration form can be mailed to you. Please note that the last day to register with Suffolk County is 10 days before the election to be assured that the registration will be in effect for the Saltaire election.

(2) The Village annual personal registration will be held 12 days before the election, and then again 10 days before the election. Contact the Village office for specific dates and times.

The Village annual personal registration is not a permanent registration. This registration is valid only for the Village election in the year in which you personally registered. Having personally registered in a prior year does not register you for the current election. Should you desire to register through the personal registration process for the current election, you must come to Saltaire and register on one of the two registration days mentioned above.

The requirements to register to vote on personal registration day are that you must be:

- (1) a United States citizen,
- (2) at least 18 years old and
- (3) a resident of New York State and the Village of Saltaire for at least 30 days prior to May 26, 2017 (the election day).

The Village of Saltaire encourages its residents to participate in the upcoming and future Village elections, but only in conformance with relevant election law. It is noted that the New York Election Law provides that any person who registers or attempts to register as an elector in more than one election district for the same election or more than once in the same election district can be found guilty of a felony. It is the responsibility of each potential voter to be assured that he or she meets all of the federal and state election law requirements for proper registration.

VILLAGE 2017 ELECTION DATES

January 27, 2017

Last day for village clerk to publish notice designating office or offices to be filled and the terms thereof.

JANUARY 27, 2017

First day for village clerk to accept applications for absentee ballots.

MARCH 10, 2017

First date that an individual may sign an independent nominating petition.

MARCH 24, 2017

Last day for board of trustees to adopt a resolution stating the polling place in each district and the hours the polls will be open which shall include at least the hours from 12:00 noon until 9:00 p.m.

APRIL 14, 2017

First day to file independent nominating petition.

APRIL 14, 2017

Last day for board of trustees to appoint election inspectors.

APRIL 21, 2017

Last day to file independent nominating petition for an office to be filled at the general village election.

May 4, 2017

Last day for board of trustees to adopt resolution stating the date, place and hour at which inspectors shall meet to prepare register and the hours and place of registration and election.

SUNDAY, MAY 14, 2017

REGISTRATION DAY. Registration hours from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

TUESDAY, MAY 16, 2017

REGISTRATION DAY. Registration hours from 12:00 noon - 5:00 p.m.

MAY 16, 2017

Last day for village clerk to publish notice stating: 1)polling place,2) hours during which polls are open,3)names and addresses of candidates, offices and term nominated for, 4) abstract of any proposition.

MAY 16, 2017

Last day to register with county board of elections to be eligible to vote in village election.

MAY 19, 2017

Last day for board of elections to provide a list of registered voters to village clerk.

MAY 19, 2017

Last day for village clerk to receive application for absentee ballot which is to be mailed to a qualified voter.

MAY 19, 2017

Last day for village clerk to mail absentee ballot to qualified voters.

MAY 25, 2017

Last day for village clerk to receive personal application for absentee ballot, from applicant or applicant's agent. Upon application, the village clerk shall deliver such absentee ballot for a qualified applicant to the applicant or agent named in such application.

FRIDAY, MAY 26, 2017

DATE OF GENERAL VILLAGE ELECTION.

MAY 26, 2017

Village clerk must deliver absentee ballots to the board of inspectors.

MAY 27, 2017

Date for inspectors to file certificate of canvass of votes with the village clerk.

MAY 29, 2017

Last day for village clerk to notify the persons that they have been elected and must take an oath of office within 30 days after they take office.
