



## Read More About the Programs Offered at the Saltaire Library Summer 2017

### Storytime with Ms. Kate

*When:* Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays 9:15-10:15, starting July 6<sup>th</sup> and ending August 25<sup>th</sup>

*Who:* Best for ages 2-4

Bring your 2, 3, and 4 year old for Storytime with Ms. Kate! Each week will be dedicated to a different children's author as we explore their writing and similarities throughout their books. They will participate in interactive games, crafts, and other activities that coincide with the book topic. Each Friday we will embark on a different adventure whether it be visiting different locations in our village or be taking a "field trip" somewhere in the community to get a better understanding of what goes on in our community.

*When:* Tuesdays 4:30-5:15

*Who:* Best for ages 6-12

Our first Kid's Book Club will be held on Tuesday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. Children will keep track of the books they read over the summer and be able to win various prizes the more they read. This program will be similar to a book club, however, each child will read their own individual book and then give their review of the book. Children are encouraged to get creative with their presentations and use props or other visuals.

*Who:* Middle/High Schoolers who must complete summer homework
