3. ROAD OPENING & CLOSURES – BASIC PARAMETERS

- a. Road Closed at 8 AM each Work Day
- b. Road must be able to be open for Emergencies
 - i. Anticipated Maximum Time to Reopen Once Notified: 20 Minutes
- c. Road Reopened at 4:30 PM each Work Day
- d. Road Open on the Weekends

4. DETOURS

- a. Water Main Installation
 - i. Existing Concrete Walkway will be demolished from Richards Walk to West Walk, in short increments, to keep ahead of Water Main Installation.
 - ii. Work Area will be covered/bridged/matted for road reopening so vehicles can travel over the area of current work.
 - iii. Reopen Times: Vehicles will be required to travel over some sand portion of the Right of Way from Richards Walk to West Walk and will be able cross over the area of work when road is reopened.
- b. Timber Installation
 - i. Piles will be installed each day to the extent that the piles will be able to be cut at or below grade by the end of each day.
 - ii. Work Area will be covered/bridged/matted for road reopening so vehicles can travel over the area of current work.
 - iii. Reopen Times: Vehicles will be required to travel over sand portions of Right of Way from East Walk to Beacon Walk and will be able cross over the bridging that is placed in the area of work.

- c. Accessible Areas: Portions of Lighthouse Promenade EST AND WEST of the Area of Work will be accessible during the Work Day from the East and West entrances of the Village, but no through-traffic will be allowed past the area of work until the road is reopened for nights and weekends, or in the event a 911 emergency.
- d. WHEN THE AREA OF WORK IS IN BETWEEN PACIFIC AND WEST WALKS, through traffic will be allowed to detour around the area of work north of Lighthouse Prom on designated walkways, under the following conditions:
 - i. All vehicles that are detoured must have valid Village of Saltaire vehicle permits
 - ii. No overweighed or oversized vehicles will be allowed on the northern walks
 - iii. If the volume of traffic remains manageable and feasible, and the Village reserves the right to limit the timeframe for such detours.
