AUTHORIZATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON LOCAL LAW TO REGULATE FILMING IN SALTAIRE

Mayor O'Brien stated that at its meeting on July 20, 2024 the Board will be holding a public hearing to consider a local law amendment to Chapter 52 to regulate the use of public property for non-governmental purposes. He further stated that this would also be an appropriate time to review and modify the existing code provisions in Chapter 38 regarding filming in Saltaire since the two sections are interconnected. Mayor O'Brien had distributed a draft amendment to Chapter 38 to the Board in

advance of the meeting. After discussion and all having a chance to be heard, Trustee Oppenheimer made a motion to hold a public hearing on July 20, 2024 to consider such an amendment to Chapter 38 of the Village Code.

APPROVAL OF 2024 FIREWORKS SHOW AND ACCEPTANCE OF DONATION

Mayor O'Brien reported that the Saltaire Events Organization (SEO) has been soliciting funds for a 2024 Fireworks show on August 3, 2024 as part of the SCA's Bay Picnic event. Administrator Posillico stated that bids for the fireworks ranged from approximately \$23,000 to \$29,515 depending upon the length of the show, with the mid-range program which has traditionally been selected by the Village at approximately \$25,000 (excluding the cost of Village staff to plan and monitor the event). Representatives of the SEO stated that they had raised approximately \$20,000 towards the event, and further requested that the Board of Trustees authorize Village expenditures to bridge the approximately \$5,000 gap between the preferred mid-range program and the \$20,000 SEO has committed. After discussion, and all having a chance to be heard, Trustee Skerritt made a motion to authorize the Village Administrator to execute a contract with Grucci Fireworks for the mid-range performance for approximately \$25,000, and to authorize him to expend not more than \$5,000 in order to offset the gap between the funds raised by the SEO and the cost of the preferred mid-range program, and accept donations from the SEO in the minimum amount of \$20,000 to be used to defray the Village's net cost of the fireworks show. The motion was seconded by Trustee Oppenheimer and on call it was carried according to the following action:
